# Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Program

Enrolled Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa (TMBC) members receiving the COVID-19 vaccine are eligible to receive a onetime \$1,000 incentive stipend from the TMBC. To receive a stipend, complete the application information below and must include a valid state or tribal enrollment photo ID, if the applicant lives outside of the state of North Dakota or received their vaccine at a facility outside of North Dakota, the applicant will need to provide a copy of their medical record that shows the vaccination records. Vaccine Cards will not be accepted.

- Eligible applicants include
  - All tribal enrolled members located in the United States, except those individuals who are incarcerated. Incarcerated individuals and those living in another country will be processed in a Phase 3 application.
  - o Fully vaccinated using the Moderna, Pfizer, or Johnson & Johnson Vaccines
  - o Were enrolled with the TMBC as of March 11, 2021
  - o Eighteen (18) years of age at the time of application.

All vaccine records and tribal enrollment records will be verified prior to distribution of the eligible benefit. Once approved, a check will be mailed to the address of record listed in the demographic section below, **no checks can be picked up**. *All fields are <u>required</u> unless otherwise notated*.

Applications must be received by the TMBC on or before June 30, 2022.

## Who is eligible for the incentive program?

- ❖ All enrolled member who are FULLY vaccinated according to the CDC Guidelines which means two doses of the Moderna or Pfizer Vaccine, or one dose of Johnson and Johnson Vaccine
- MUST BE 18 years or older at the time of application
- Resident of the United States
- If you are applying on behalf of someone in which you have Conservatorship, you must include legal documentation that you are the legal guardian.

## Why are only US residents eligible for the incentive?

Currently only US resident applications are being accepted and processed because of the large amount of tribal members who live throughout the world, the consulting team advised the Tribal Council to add an additional phase which would include those members who do not live in the US or are Incarcerated.

#### When will Phase 2 applications be accepted?

• February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022

- Applicants must you will need to include
  - Completed signed application
  - Verification of Identity-state or tribal issued ID
  - If you are a US resident who received your vaccines anywhere but in the state of ND you will need to include a copy of your vaccine medical record showing the required doses of the vaccine.

#### Can I mail my application?

- o If mailing application you will need to include:
  - Completed signed application
  - Verification of Identity-state or tribal issued ID
  - If you are a US resident who received your vaccines anywhere but in the state of ND you
    will need to include a copy of your vaccine medical record showing the required doses
    of the vaccine.

#### What is the purpose of the incentive program?

To increase the vaccination rates for our Tribal Members.

## How long will it take to receive my check?

Enrollment and vaccination will be verified before any check is processed. The entire process may take 30 days.

#### What documentation must I present?

- Valid Tribal ID and/or Valid state issued ID
- Completed and signed application

#### Do I need to include my Vaccine Card?

TMBCI will not accept a Vaccine Card as proof that you received your required doses of the vaccine. If you are a US resident who received your vaccines anywhere but in the state of ND you will need to include a copy of your vaccine medical record showing the required doses of the vaccine.

## What if my tribal ID has expired?

Yes, you can use an expired ID

#### If I do not have a state issued ID or a Tribal ID?

- Visit the TM motor vehicle department to receive a new ID
- Application fee will be waived

#### Where will I be receiving my check?

\* Your check will be mailed to the address you provide on the application. To mitigate the spread of COVID we will not allow any checks to be picked up at the Tribal office.

#### Why are vaccinated children aged 5-17 not eligible for the incentive payment?

At this time, TMBCI is seeking legal opinion on providing vaccine incentive payments to children under the age of 18.

#### Do I need to have the booster dose to receive the incentive.

No, but it is highly encouraged

## What if I am not vaccinated, can I receive the incentive payment

- If you choose to get the vaccine, you will need to have received 2 shots of Moderna or Pfizer, or one dose of the Johnson and Johnson.
- If you choose not to be vaccinated then, NO you are not eligible to receive the incentive.
